CAPIC has serious concerns regarding the approach and program promoted by the government representatives connected to this event. CAPIC believes this event is to facilitate connections between the Punjabi government and Canadian-based DLIs and that ultimately will undermine the independence of the immigration process and undermine the credibility of Canada's system.

As such, CAPIC will not be participating in this event and believes the College will be at risk if it works with a foreign government that is acting as an unauthorized representative.
