Thank you for your letter of March 17, 2016, to Mr. Eric Johansen regarding *The Foreign Worker Recruitment and Immigration Services Act (FWRISA)* which was referred to me for response. Please accept my apologies for the delay of this response. As was communicated to you previously, we were unable to communicate on policy matters such as those raised in your letter during Saskatchewan's provincial election campaign, which concluded earlier this month.

The Government of Saskatchewan appreciates the time and effort that the Canadian Association of Professional Immigration Consultants (CAPIC) has invested in reviewing the FWRISA and its implementation. I assure you that careful consideration was given to the constitutional and program responsibilities of the provincial and federal governments in the drafting of this legislation. I can also give assurances that, in collecting and sharing information under FWRISA, we are committed to complying with all legal requirements protecting the privacy of individuals.

Your letter raises some operational matters concerning the administration of the FWRISA and we thank you for sharing your views with us and for your interest in the FWRISA.
