



Question/Concern:

Immigration Practitioners have noticed some delays in eCOPR issuance - in some cases, the to-be permanent resident has been waiting over 3 months for their eCOPR which only a couple of months ago was issued within approximately 1 - 2 weeks.

Response:

"In order to stay within approved levels commitments, the Department prioritized case processing resulting in some clients with approved files facing delays in receiving their PR status (or E-COPR). The Department is currently focusing on working through the virtual admissions process and the wait time should decrease moving forward."
