Current Pain Points

- Limited search capabilities
- Disorganized menu structure
- Buried information
- Content overload: dense information presentation; lack of visual hierarchy
- Upcoming events and training need to be more prominent
- Membership application requirements are too detailed. Not simple enough. More prominent membership categories information

www.myconsultant.ca

- Challenging navigation due to overwhelming unorganized content, presented in a very dense format. Extensive and overlapping categories of posts
- Not enough visual aids
- Forum registration and participation is difficult and not straightforward
- Member directory is not prominent enough
- No dedicated area and format for sponsors info. Sponsors' information mixed with website content

- Navigation complexity
- Cluttered information presentation
- Inconsistent French version
- Registration process and details (installment plans for example) must be more prominent
- Not enough visual aids
